

## To ALL students: 3<sup>rd</sup> Urgent Notification regarding the New Coronavirus

The number of people infected with the new coronavirus has been increasing all over Japan. In order to take countermeasures against infection, please follow the instructions below if you meet any of the following conditions.

In February 2020 or after, if you (A) entered or returned to Japan from overseas or (B) have been staying in Japan and developed cold symptoms such as cough and fever, **please make sure to call and inform the university from the numbers listed in (1) below.**

When you call, we will give you instructions as to health monitoring. Please act as instructed.

- ◆ Measure your body temperature every day for two weeks after the day of reporting.
- ◆ Avoid going out for unnecessary or non-urgent matters.
- ◆ Isolate yourself at home (in Japan) and keep in close contact with the university.

- ◆ You're experiencing cold symptoms or having a fever of 37.5 °C or above for 4 days or more ( or for about 2 days if you have any pre-existing disease).
- ◆ You have a strong sense of fatigue or difficulty of breathing.

Two weeks have passed without any cold symptoms appearing.

Please keep on paying close attention to your health condition. Please inform the university if you have developed symptoms again.
